Year 1 Spring Term 2 on a page

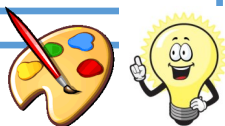
Maths

We will start the term by learning to recognise, order and compare numbers to 50. After that we will be learning to measure the length, height, mass and volume of different objects.



Art

In Art we will be using paper to make 3D sculptures using techniques such as rolling and shaping strips of paper.



Geography/History

This term's big question is 'What is the weather like in the UK?' We will be learning about the seasons and observing weather patterns.



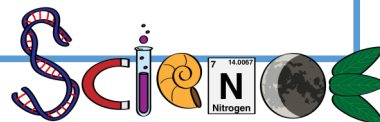
Music

In Music we will be exploring changes of pitch and using this when performing songs about seasons.



Science

We will start the term learning to identify common animals and learning which are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores. On 8th March we will be visiting Sacrewell Farm where we will be learning about new life and animal welfare.



Computing

We will be grouping and organising data and labelling the groups we have made.



PE

This term the children will be developing their ball skills including throwing and catching.



PSHE

The topic this term is called 'Healthy Me'. The children will be thinking about how to stay happy, healthy and safe.

English

In Year One we will be continuing with the Read Write Inc program to teach the skills needed to read and write.

During Book Week we will explore the story 'Me' by Emma Dodd. The story is written from the perspective of a little penguin and the children will use this text as a stimulus to write their own animal story.



RE

In RE we will be continuing to learn about the Islamic faith. We will think about how Muslims express their beliefs and which celebrations are important to them. We will learn about the importance of Ramadan to Muslims and how Eid al-Fitr is celebrated.
