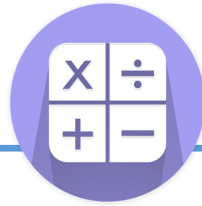

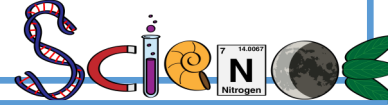


Maths: Length and perimeter, fractions and decimals

We will be concluding our first unit with calculating perimeter of different shapes. Children will then work with fractions and understand improper fractions, they will add and subtract fractions. We will then investigate decimals and look at how decimals and fractions link.

Science: Electricity

We will be learning about different appliances that require electricity and then building our own circuits. We will investigate different materials to test materials for conductivity and discover different insulators.



English: The adventures of Robin Hood and Marian by Adrian Mitchell

We will be reading stories about Robin Hood and writing our own character descriptions. Children will then be writing their own stories of Robin Hood and his adventures. We will finish the term by writing our own poems about Robin Hood and his friends of Sherwood forest.



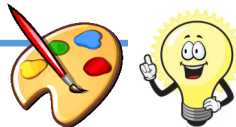
Computing: Hardware investigators

Children will learn about and be able to recognise essential parts of a computer. They will explore each parts function and be able to explain to others why they are important.

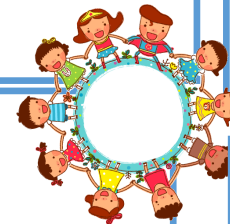
History- USA Road-trip
