Maths

Next term, we will complete our learning on algebra and decimals before consolidating all that the children have learned ready for their SATS in the 4th week of term.



RE: Life Journey: How do Hindus show they belong?

Children will consider the main beliefs of Hinduism and how they influence the lives of Hindus. They will think about their own duties and will also reflect on and discuss their own answers to some much bigger questions.



Spanish

Children will read a menu from a Spanish café. They will practise ordering food and will work on their pronunciation.



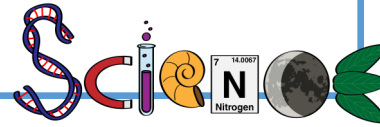
PE

Athletics and rounders will be our PE units over the next term.



Science: Healthy Lifestyles and Variation

The children will complete their module looking at healthy lifestyles, including learning information about smoking and drugs. Following this, we will begin our unit on genetics and variation amongst living things.



Computing: Blogging and Coding

Children will continue last term's unit on coding, revising their skills from the last few years and culminating in the design, creation, debugging and evaluation of their own text-based adventure game.



History: Who should feature on the £10 banknote?

Children will use a range of sources to extract information. They will apply their own criteria to decide if a person is historically significant and explain why, before deciding on which historical figure should appear on the banknote.



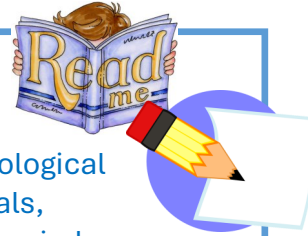
Art: Sculpture and 3D: Making Memories

Children learn to represent memories through art, using various materials and techniques, and develop skills in planning, creating, and evaluating 3D sculptures.



English

We will continue to redraft and publish our non-chronological reports on endangered animals, making sure that we include varied sentences and accurate punctuation. We will also write short stories and newspaper reports. Another focus will be revising grammar and spelling knowledge, ready for our SATs.



PSHE: Relationships

Children will think about their mental health and identify strategies to help themselves and others. They will find out about peer pressure and how to resist pressure before moving on to taking responsibility for their own safety and wellbeing.



Music:

Children will explore the musical concept of 'theme and variations' and discover how rhythms can 'translate' onto different instruments.
