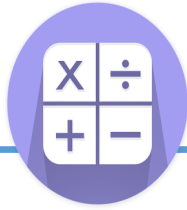




Let your light shine!

Year 1 Autumn 1 Term on a page



Maths– Number and place value within 10

We will be sorting, counting and representing objects. We will be learning to write numbers in words and numerals and count one more, one less, forwards and backwards. We will also be comparing and ordering groups and numbers, and using number lines in our counting.



DT– Structures- We will be learning about different structures and how ones with a wider base are more stable than ones with a narrow base. We will be designing our own structures and exploring methods for joining.



Geography– What is it like to live here?

We will be locating features on aerial photographs and naming the country and town we live in. We will be using maps to explore features, distance and direction. We will be learning to draw and design maps.

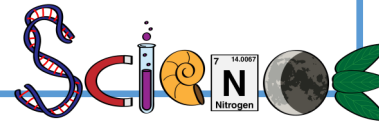
Music– Keeping the Pulse

Children will be learning to keep the pulse together through music and movement, by exploring their favourite things



Science-Animals

We will be learning to identify and name and compare a variety of common animals, including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will be identifying and naming animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.



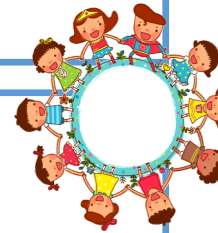
Computing– Coding

We will be using Purple Mash to log in and log out safely saving our work. We will be exploring technology to create, organise and store our work.



PE– Dance/ Ball Skills

We will be exploring dynamics, space and learn to work together safely and creatively, We will explore and develop ball skills such as throwing, catching, rolling and dribbling with hands and feet.



PSHE– Being in my world

We will be learning to understand the rights and responsibilities as a member of the class. We will identify when we are proud and share this with others.



English

We will be reading a range of books around our topic, 'Amazing Animals', including 'Giraffe's Can't Dance,' 'Owl Babies' and 'Monkey Puzzle'. This half term we will be recapping our phonics sounds and tricky words learnt so far and learning our new phonics sets. Our writing will be focusing on independent writing, writing lists and captions, and learning about simple punctuation and grammar, such as full stops and capital letters.



RE– Understanding Christianity

We will be identifying what a parable is and telling the story of The Lost Son from the Bible. We will be learning what Christians believe about God and forgiveness. We will be asking questions and relating what we have learnt to our lives.
