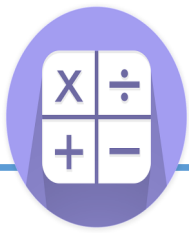


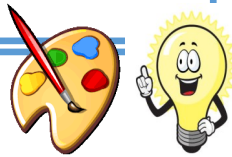


Let your light shine!



Maths

Music— Ballads

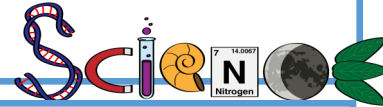
It's time to learn about ballads. We sing and perform ballads & recognise features of the genre.

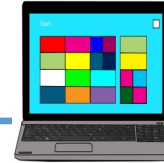
Science — Rocks & Soil

We will explore different rocks and soils & classify them based on different criteria. We will learn how rocks & fossils are formed & how the Earth is made of different layers.



Computing

In computing we will be learning about staying safe online, as well as efficiently accessing PurpleMash to save and retrieve work.
