

Purpose

This policy sets out the expectations for school uniform at St. George's C of E Primary and School. Wearing uniform promotes a sense of belonging, equality, and pride in our school community.

Government Guidance on Affordable Uniforms

In line with the UK government's guidance on affordable school uniforms, St. George's C of E Primary School is committed to keeping costs reasonable for families. We aim to limit the number of branded or logo items required, allowing parents to purchase generic alternatives where possible. This approach ensures inclusivity and affordability while maintaining our school identity.

General Principles

- All pupils are required to wear school uniform during the school day.
- Uniform does not need to be branded with the school logo; generic items in the correct colours are acceptable.
- All uniform items should be clearly labelled with the child's name.
- Uniform can be purchased from Nationwide's school uniform website [St George's C of E Primary School \(Stamford\) - Primary & Nursery - Select Your School](#) or from other retailers, provided colours and styles match the school guidelines.

Uniform Requirements

Boys uniform

Winter – from beginning of Term 2 to end of Term 4	Summer – Terms 1, 5 and 6
Plain white polo shirt Navy v neck sweatshirt or cardigan with logo (or plain navy) Grey long trousers Grey socks Black shoes Logo book bag (optional)	Children may replace grey long trousers with grey shorts as an alternative.

Girls uniform

Winter – from beginning of Term 2 to end of Term 4	Summer – Terms 1, 5 and 6
Plain white polo shirt Navy v neck sweatshirt or cardigan with logo (or plain navy) Grey skirt or grey long trousers Grey socks or tights Black shoes Logo book bag (optional)	Red and white gingham dress, white socks or Grey shorts instead of trousers

PE Kit (All Pupils)

- Red PE t-shirt with logo
- Red **round** neck jumper with logo
- Navy shorts
- White socks
- Black plimsolls or non-marking trainers
- Navy jogging bottoms for outdoor PE (winter months)
- PE kit bag (logo or plain)

Additional Guidance

- Children must have an appropriate coat for winter months (any colour).
- Logo items should be purchased from Nationwide Uniform Supplier [St George's C of E Primary School \(Stamford\) - Primary & Nursery - Select Your School](#)
- No uniform is sold on-site, although the PTA have a selection of pre-loved items which can be purchased at a reduced price. Please contact the school office to find out more.
