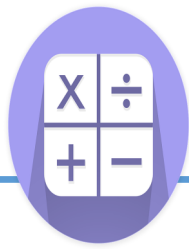

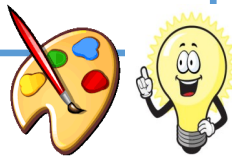


## Maths

In this term we will begin our learning on Fractions. We will explore quarters, halves and thirds, learning how to recognise a fraction and then use them to find a whole. Following this we will be learning how to tell the time.

## Music—Structure

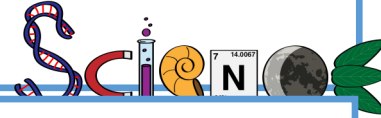
In music we will be developing an understanding of structure in music by exploring and ordering rhythms.

## Computing

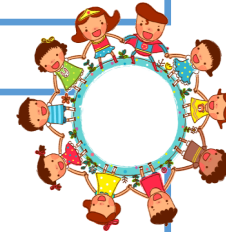
In I.T. we will be using computers to make patterns, rhythms and tunes to create digital music pieces.
