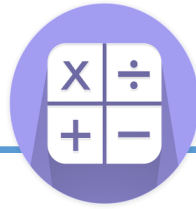


EYFS Summer Term 6 on a page



Maths Children will develop their understanding of spatial reasoning through the topics Visualise, Build and Map and Make Connections. They will explore how objects can be represented, arranged and linked, building confidence in describing position, patterns and relationships through practical, hands-on activities.



Understanding the World Children will explore the topic *What's in my basket?* They will talk about and investigate different materials, noticing similarities, differences and changes. Through engaging, practical experiences children will begin to develop their understanding of how materials change over time.

Expressive Arts and Design In Art, children will explore painting and mixed media, developing their creativity through experimenting with colour, tools and techniques. They will have opportunities to explore texture and form, building confidence in expressing their ideas through creative play.



Characteristics of Effective Teaching and Learning

Active learning – children concentrate and keep on trying if they encounter difficulties and enjoy their achievements for their own sake.



Communication and Language

Children will continue to take home a library book for reading for pleasure. The children will have lots of speech and language opportunities in their home role play corner and through sensory play.



Physical Development In PE, children will develop their physical skills through athletics and striking and fielding activities. They will practise coordination, movement and simple game-based decisions, such as moving into space and working cooperatively with others.



PSHE . We will focus on the theme *Changing Me*. Children will learn about change in a positive way, developing strategies to help them cope with new experiences and feelings.



Literacy

This term we will explore the story Jack and the Beanstalk. We will act out this story and learn new vocabulary from the book.

In phonics we will consolidate Set 1 sounds and special friends until they become automatic and speedy on recall. We will also be beginning to teach Set 2 sounds.



RE

In RE, the children will learn about different festivals from Christianity, Islam and Judaism. We will be exploring why Easter, Passover and Ramadan are celebrated, how they are celebrated and what believers learn from these.
